

## CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES 2026

Dear Parent/Guardian

The School Board has recently endorsed the *Schedule of Contributions and Charges* for 2026. This information is provided now so you may organise your finances in preparation for the following year.

### Voluntary Contributions

The voluntary contribution is **\$60.00 per child**. These contributions are important to the school and used to purchase items such as classroom resources and consumables, IT and computer equipment, and school/home communications. Contributions can be paid along with your Student Requirements list through Campion, or via the payment methods attached.

### P&C Contribution

The Gwynne Park ESC P&C Association has requested an amount of **\$20.00 per child**. Funds raised through the P&C directly benefit our children through the provision of subsidised activities or resources, activities or events.

### Incursions / Excursions and Additional Program Costs

In *Section 100 of the Education Act*, the school is asked to inform parents and carers regarding voluntary programs which may be scheduled for the following year. There is a requirement to predict over twelve months in advance; therefore, the costs below are provided as a ***maximum estimate*** for the year. Once the school has delivered the upper limit for each activity, this limit cannot be exceeded. In some cases, the maximum limit may not be reached.

These costs are educational experiences which relate to incursions, excursions and special programs and will be requested throughout the year.

| Activity                     | Who          | Amount                 |

| Swimming                     | All students | \$120 maximum per year |
| Incursions & Excursions      | All students | \$100 per year         |
| Year 5/6 Combined Camp       | Year 5/6     | \$350                  |
| Year 6 Graduation and events | Year 6       | \$80                   |
